### Additional information

#### Contents & Purpose

Students should choose a myth to create a storyboard and separate the story into the 6 elements of the narrative arc: Exposition, conflict, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution. This lesson teaches students how to break down and understand a given myth and explain the importance of each stage in the plot.
